SUPPORTING CHILDREN

Parents will work with Club staff to support their child's overall progress and development.

Parents will be supportive in their child's development of values such as respect, cooperation, competition, and teamwork.

Parents will model positive and responsible behaviour and expect their children to do the same.

Parents will work to instill confidence in their child's ability and skill development, always avoiding comparisons with other program participants.

SUPPORTING OTHER MEMBERS

Parents will conduct themselves in a responsible manner consistent with the values of fair play, integrity, open communication, and mutual respect.

Parents will treat all individuals and property with dignity, courtesy, and respect.

Parents will refrain from behaviour or comments that are hostile, violent, profane, insulting, harassing, sexist, racist, abusive, disrespectful or otherwise offensive, or that contradicts the Club's Anti-Discrimination/Harassment Policy and Anti-Bullying Policy.

SUPPORTING CLUB STAFF

Parents will assume the major responsibility for their child's conduct and attitude during Club programs or activities.

Parents will respect that Club staff are responsible and empowered for the development of the participants.

Parents will bring all concerns related to the program and/or program participants to a Club staff and respect the Club staff's role to address these concerns.
